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# CENTRAL BROWARD EAST-WEST TRANSIT ANALYSIS



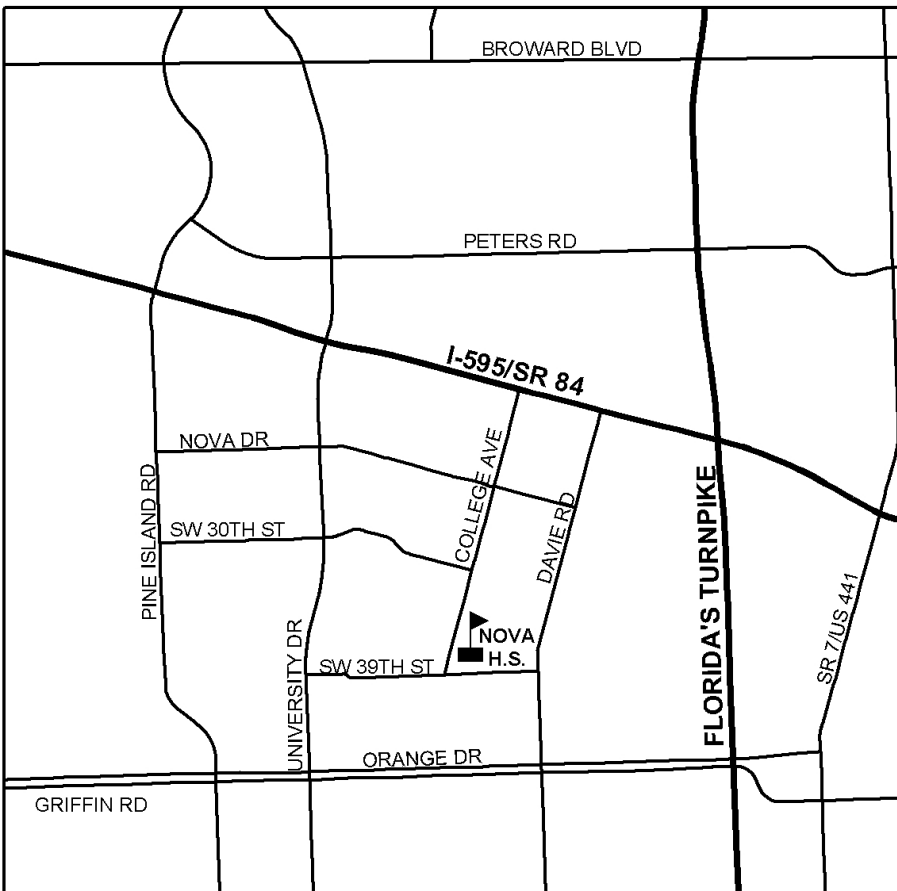
## PUBLIC WORKSHOP SCHEDULED

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to attend a public workshop regarding the Central Broward East/West Transit Analysis study. This workshop will be held on Thursday, February 19, 2004, in the cafeteria at Nova High School, 3600 College Avenue, Davie, Florida (see map below). The workshop will be conducted as an informal open house and citizens are invited to attend at any time during the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. A presentation will be given at 6:00 p.m.

The FDOT is conducting the Central Broward East-West Transit Analysis study to determine the most beneficial alignment and appropriate type of premium transit service for Central Broward County. Four potential alignments and two transit technologies (light rail and bus rapid transit) were identified during the first phase of the study. Each alignment would provide transit service to the Office Depot Center/Sawgrass Mills Mall area and to Downtown Fort Lauderdale and the Fort Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport. Two of the potential alignments follow Sunrise Boulevard to Broward Boulevard, using either University Drive or SR 7 as a north-south connector. The other two alignments are located within the I-595 right-of-way connecting to Downtown Fort Lauderdale and the Airport via SR 7 and Broward Boulevard or via SR 84 and Andrews Avenue.

This workshop is being held to present the results of the Tier 2 Analysis and to afford persons the opportunity to provide additional input. FDOT and consultant representatives will be present at the workshop to informally discuss the project, receive public input, and answer questions.
